### IT'S WARMIA, FOR PETE'S SAKE!

If you want to piss us off, say that Olasztyu lies in the Mazury region. It doesn't, obviously. It's Warmia, and better remember that for the rest of your life or at least for the rest of your trip. Even though the closest airport name can be confusing - don't even try to make that mistake. Ever.

### DON'T ASK CERTAIN QUESTIONS

Every Olasztyu citizen knows this local star and you can't miss his gig. He appears pretty much every weekend between the High Gate and the Old City Hall, no matter the weather. If you hear guitar playing from a distance, come closer and listen to the smashing hits of the 80s polish rock and blues. In no time you'll be able to hum the chorus for Lady Pank's *Zawsze tam, gdzie Ty*.

### MOST OLASZTYN THINGS

### 1. WELCOME TO MY CRIB

I left some of my things there for you to see, as well as my only preserved instrument in the world - my astronomical board. My time in Olasztyu was so inspiring to my research, that later on I published my thesis on heliocentric model of the universe.

But if you're keen to also try pierogi with mushroom, duck or strawberries, visit: **Fleogarnia Burner**. They also serve other food, like fish or salads, but pierogi is a must-eat there.

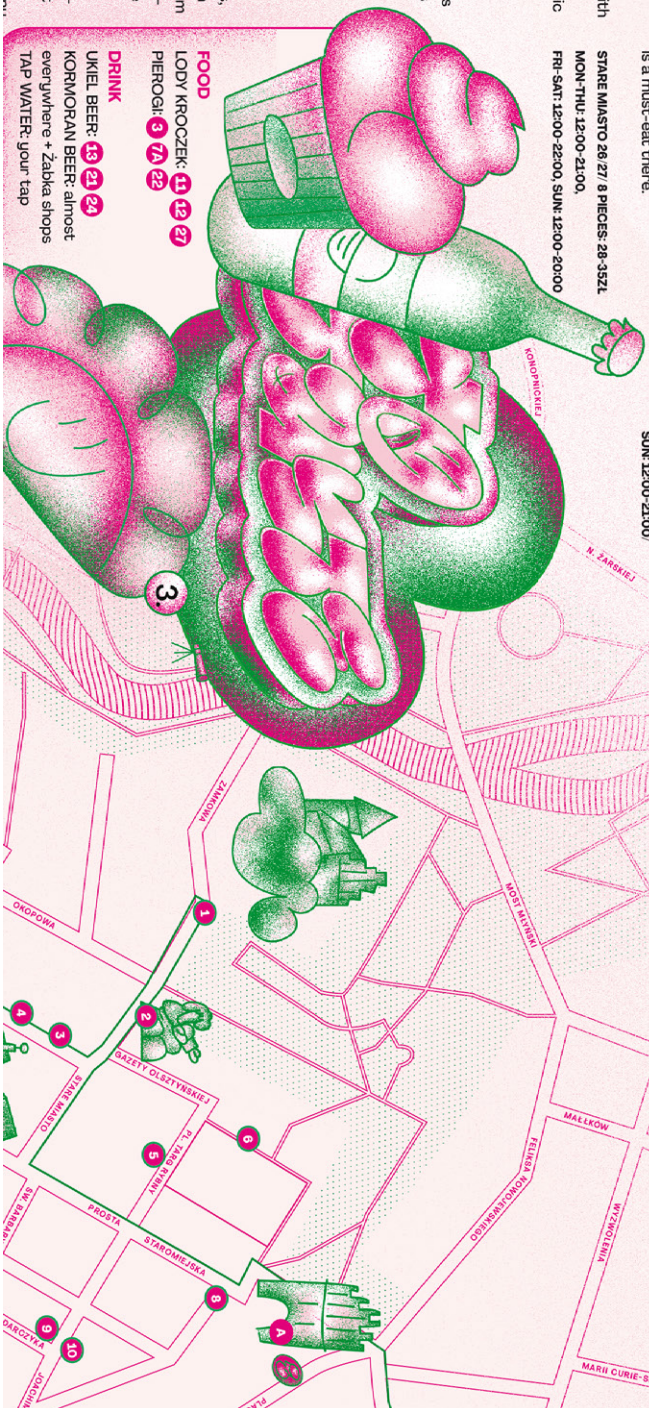

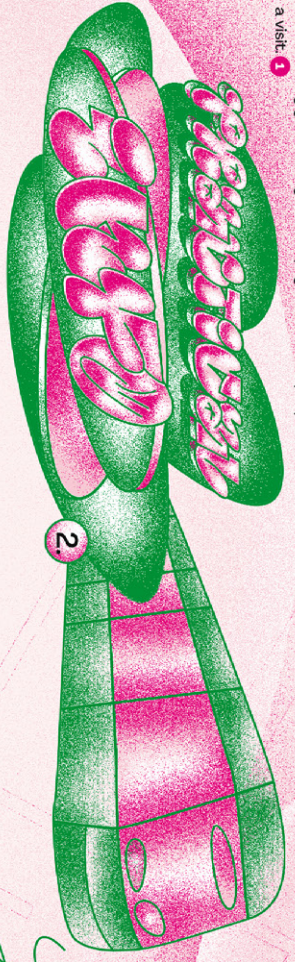

**ARRIVAL:** We strongly advise you to get off the train at the new OLSZTYN ZACHODNI STATION. The city center and the Old Town are relatively nearby. It's best to avoid the Central Station (Olsztyn Główny) just because it doesn't really exist right now due to construction work.

**PUBLIC TRANSPORT:** If you don't feel like walking today, you can take a public bus or train (normal tickets 4zł, half tickets - for students - 2zł, and also affordable weekend tickets). Ticket machines are at the stops and on the buses and trams where you can pay with a card. You can also use the SkyCash mobile app. Remember to carry the ticket in case of control.

**PAVEMENTS:** Poland is a card-friendly country - so is Olsztyn. You can use your credit card pretty

much everywhere, so do not stress if you don't have any cash. Most of the food places in Olsztyn close at 22:00 and some even at 20:00 - so plan your dinner wisely! Remember that malls and shops are closed on Sundays (except Zabka shops).

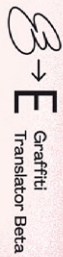
**RED LIGHTS:** DO NOT cross the street at a red light. Our law strictly prohibits it and you most likely won't spot anyone doing that. Our local drivers are very friendly though. Everyone stops before zebra crossings to let pedestrians and bikers pass.

**ALCOHOL:** Drinking alcohol outdoors is stroooongly prohibited, so don't get into troubles with Straż Miejska and choose to drink in the bars or restaurants.



**BIKES:** We used to have cool public bikes, but the pandemic hit our city hard and the authorities gave up on them since then. If you want to get from point A to point B quickly try commercial scooters and electric bikes by Bolt. Download the app and have a good ride! Remember: one scooter, one person - other combinations are strictly forbidden. And stay outside the red areas on the Bolt map! But if you're looking for a bike for a chill cycling trip - you can rent one by Ukiel Lake. **28**

This is THE bar for all of the gamers, geeks and nerds. At **Cybermachine**, apart from game-themed sports and drinks such as Mana Potion served in laboratory flasks, you can also play lots of different board games, use their consoles and meet like-minded people!



**12. THE CUL ICE-CREAM**

This iconic ice-cream comes straight from Olaszyn and its indisputable must try: **Kroczek** ice-cream are the best thing to eat on a hot summer day, while sipping the Old Town or sitting by the Ukiel lake. Enjoy the variety of flavors like salted caramel, basil, carrot or the one and only pine with honey. Slay 'pol na pol' (half and half) and you'll get two huge scoops, considered as one.



**15. QUEER BINGO AND MORE**

**Poza Space** is the only place in Olaszyn where you can enjoy queer bingo and drag queens shows. The pub has three floors and a summer garden and is located in a cute artsy street. Have an Aperol Spritz or Kornoran beer and grab your bingo card - you may win a free vodka shot!

**Rolli** is a small, planet-friendly restaurant that operates like a fast-food place, but serves high-quality, fresh sushi rolls, seafood and vegan varieties. **A. RENDEZVOUS POINT AND THE HUGE HOLE**

It's one of the crucial monuments and the best preserved part of the medieval fortifications. You may wonder what the huge hole in the ground right in front of it is - well, no one knows. 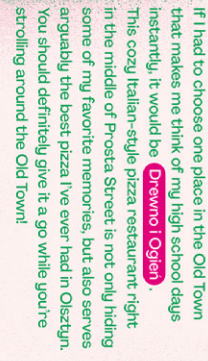
**17. A FRIENDLY CAFE**

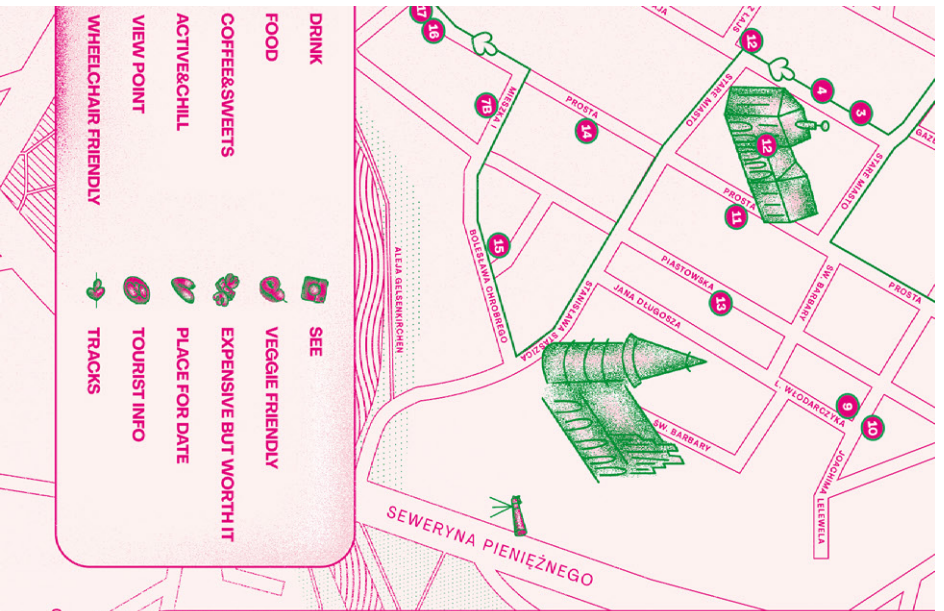
Good music, smiling staff and loads of vegan cakes - this is what **Kofka** is well-known for. Lots of us go here for catch-up coffees with long-lost friends or to pretend to work. Take a sit and have a coffee from local and beloved Kofikada Coffee Roastery, and definitely try Kofka's cinnamon rolls - they've saved more than one broken soul!

**20. FIRST WORK OF A FAMOUS ARCHITECT**

One of my favorite buildings here represents the German-Jewish-Polish history of the city like no other. It's hidden on a small **Zuradama 2** Maszkowice lane: the **Dom Mendelschna** (Mendelsohn House). Completed in 1913 as the first building of genius Olaszyn-born architect Erich Mendelsohn, this was originally a Bat Tahara, a mortuary for the adjacent Jewish cemetery. Today, the House is a centre of intercultural dialogue by the Borussia Foundation and I really enjoy visiting the workshops, concerts or readings here - sometimes they even let me on stage under the beautifully domed roof to read something.

**B. COME HERE AT NOON**

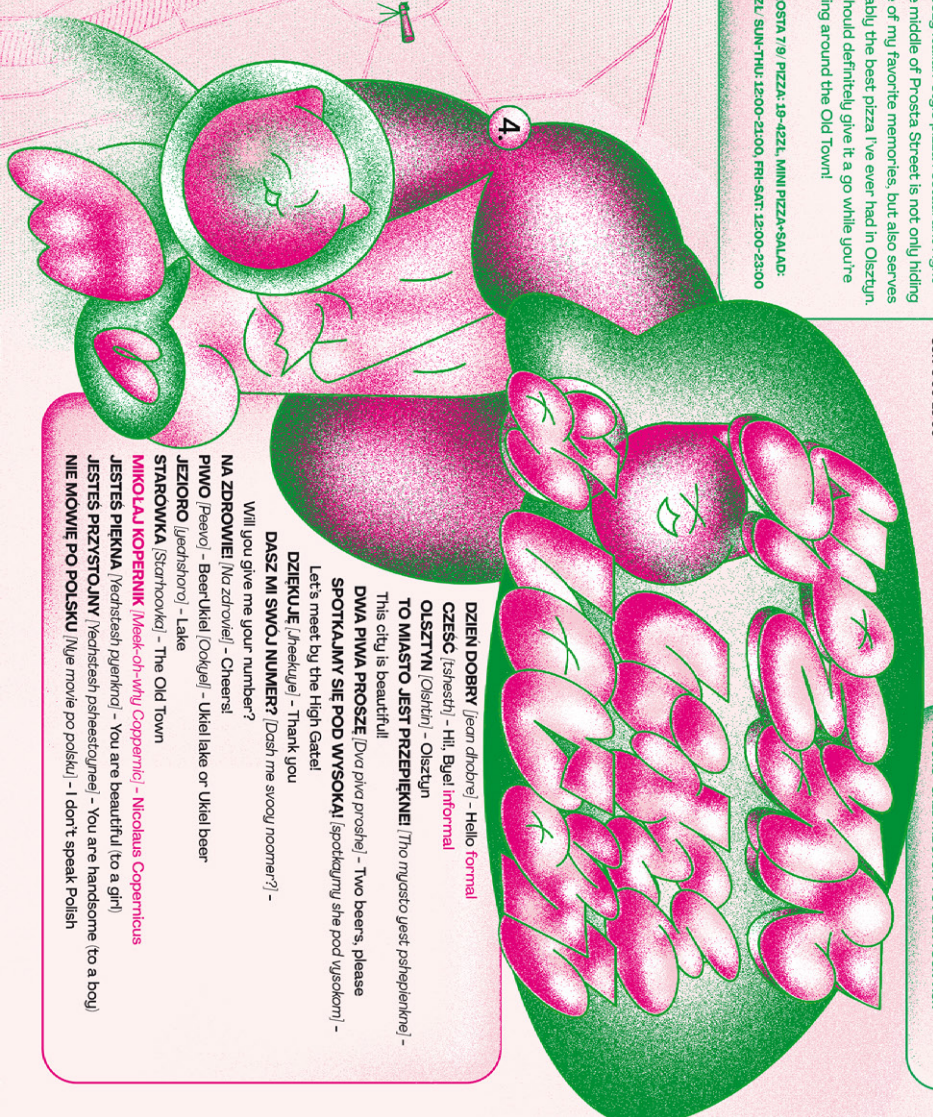
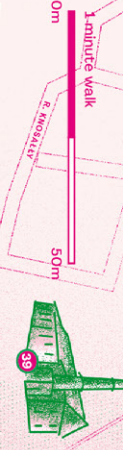
One of the most popular Instagram buildings in the city centre, photographed from all directions and angles. This is our **City Hall** where every day at high noon a trumpeter appears on the tower and plays the official bugle call *O Warmio moją nia!* (Oh my beloved Warmia), which is good proof we like to highlight Oliszyn is part of Warmia! In front of the building there's some space to rest on a bench and use the WiFi spot.

**C. THE MEETING POINT**

After the High Gate, this is the second most typical rendezvous point in Oliszyn **St. John's Bridge**, also the oldest bridge in the city. The area of the Old Town begins here (or ends, if you approach the bridge from the High Gate). In 1940, when trams were still in operation here, one of the trams didn't brake in time, derailed and fell into the Lyna river. Luckily, no one was hurt. That might be due to the monument of St. John of Nepomuk, the patron saint of safe river crossings. And there is a tradition of rubbing St. John's feet for good luck. But watch the pigeons - they like to sit on St. John's head.

In the middle of Prosta Street is not only hiding some of my favorite memories, but also serves arguably the best pizza I've ever had in Oliszyn. You should definitely give it a go while you're strolling around the Old Town!

**KORTOWIADA (MAY - ANNUALY)**

**OLSZTYN GREEN FESTIVAL (AUGUST - ANNUALY)**

If you visit Olsztyn in August, this is an event worth checking out. This music festival takes place right on the beach by the Ukiel and the artists are always the current top Polish musicians. If the spot and music isn't enough of a reason to go there, this festival's main theme is ecology and sustainability. Each year, they come up with different ways to make it "green" by for example exchanging your plastic water bottles for tickets and your electronic waste for plants. You can fill up your water bottles for free and find out more about sustainability at one of the many stands there. Tickets sell out quickly so check out Olsztyn Green Festival Facebook page.

**OLSZTYNEK**

We don't know if Kopernik ever visited Olsztyn, but it's included in Szlak Kopernikowski thanks to its castle ruins and cool ethnographic park. Good place to explore Warmia history and unique culture. Only 15 minutes by train and 15 minutes walk to get there. Everyone was there at some point of their Warmia life.

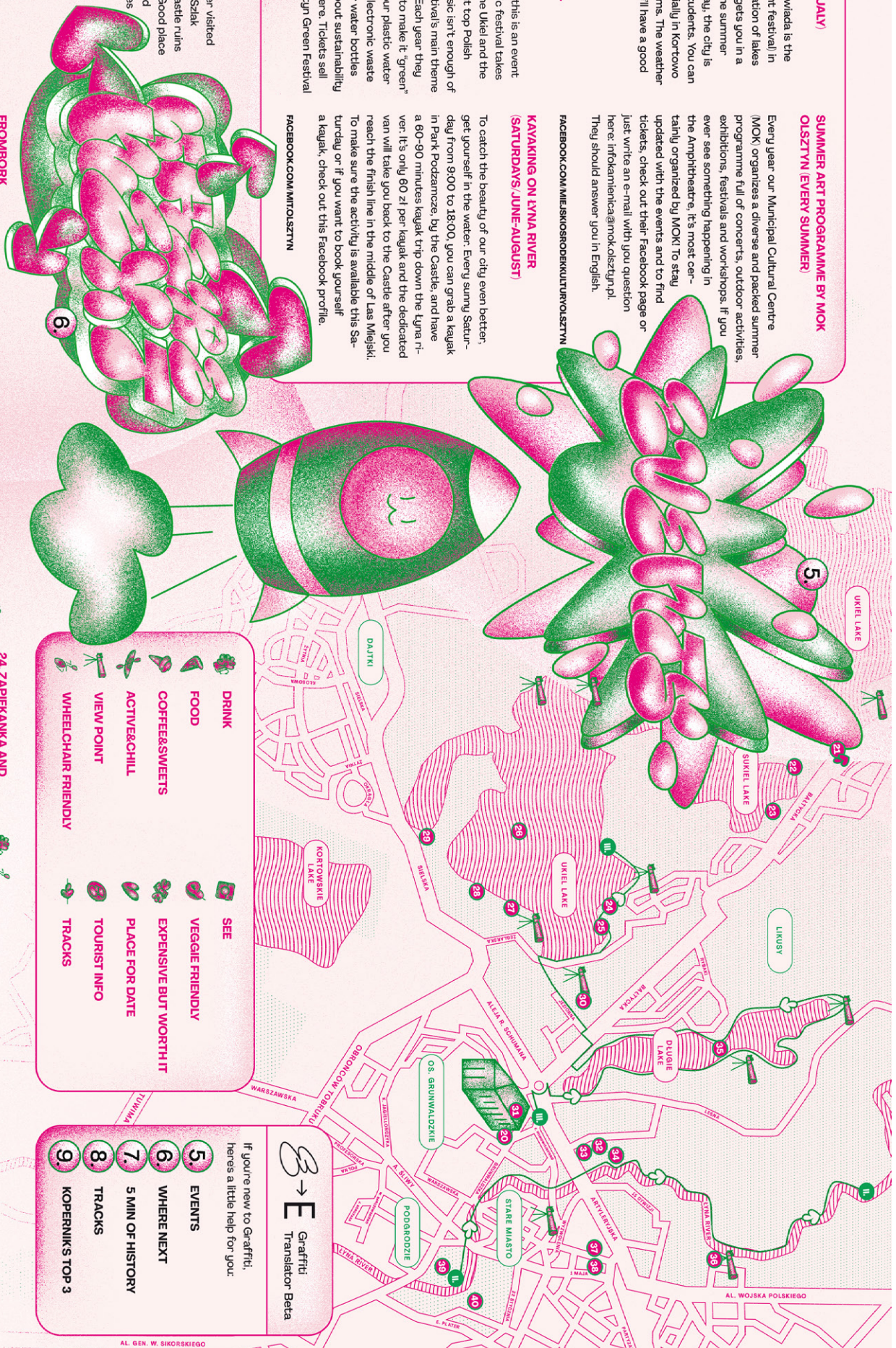
**SUMMER ART PROGRAMME BY MOK OLSZTYN (EVERY SUMMER)**

**KAYAKING ON LYNA RIVER (SATURDAYS, JUNE-AUGUST)**

To catch the beauty of our city even better, get yourself in the water. Every sunny Saturday from 9:00 to 18:00, you can grab a kayak in Park Podzamcze, by the Castle, and have a 60-90 minutes kayak trip down the Lyna river. It's only 60 zł per kayak and the dedicated van will take you back to the Castle after you reach the finish line in the middle of Las Miejski. **FROMBORK**

This tiny, cute town, right by the Vistula Lagoon, is the place Kopernik spent most of his life and is buried there. Go up the castle hill, visit the museum or planetarium and oblige! Look over the town from the castle hill like Kopernik used to do.

**21. LOCAL BEER UNDER THE STARS**

You might be looking for a fresh local beer after your bike trip around Ukiel Lake. Best place to have it is the brewery and pub named after the lake - **Ukieł**. You can enjoy their award-winning West Coast IPA either inside - with the football game on-screen, or in the garden - with the silence of Olsztyn's most chill suburbs called Gutkowo. If you're lucky enough, you might be blessed with the presence of the VIP employees of the brewery - the cats.

**24. ZAPLEKANKA AND BEER IN A PRIVATE GARDEN**

While walking along Ukiel lakes main promenade, you may want to have a zaplekanka (typical Polish snack made of grilled bread, cheese and mushrooms). Go to **Przystanek Dębowa** (Dębowa Stop) - a summer bar run by a family in their own garden. You may see a lot of bikes parked there, since the bar is a usual stop for cyclists. 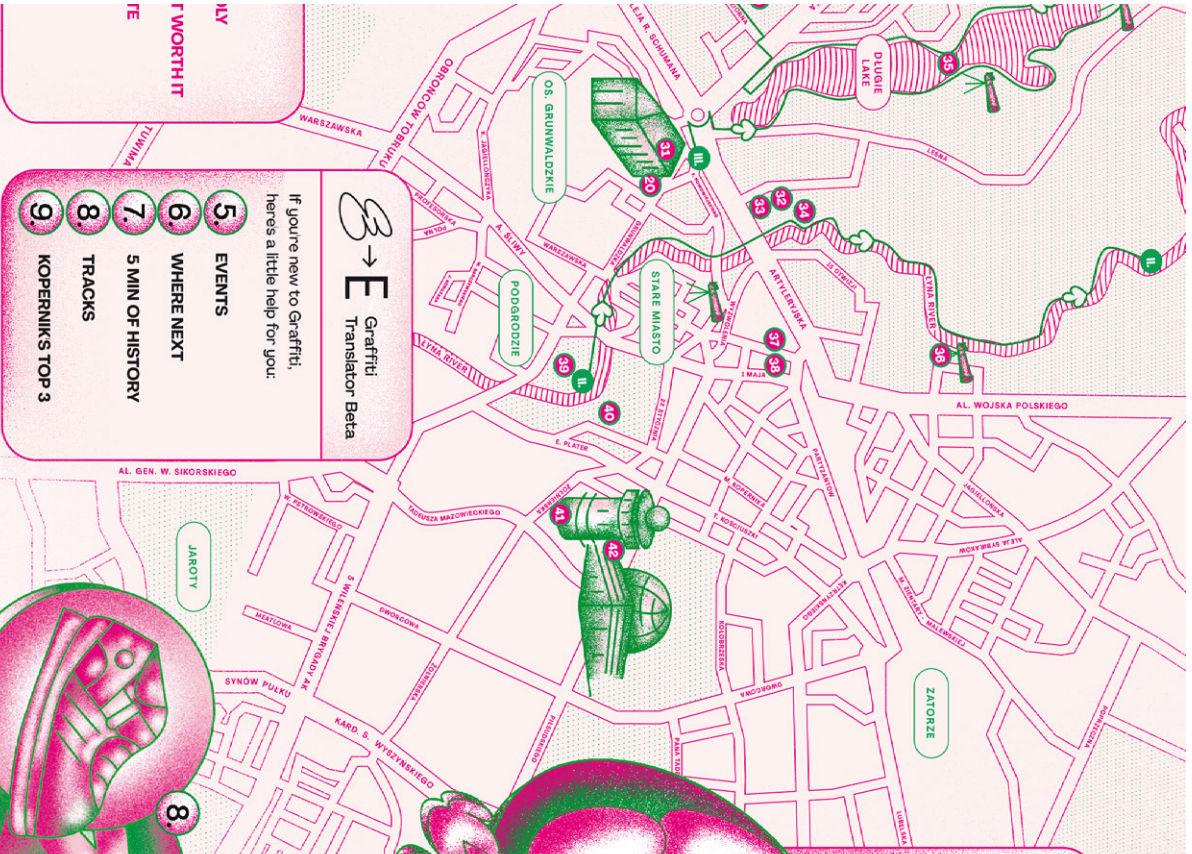

Walk slowly through the Old Town, take a picture of the Old City hall and the buildings around it and then walk up to the statue of Mikolaj Kopernik to rub his nose. The next obvious stop should be the castle - take a tour inside if you wish. After

**II. BIKE TRACK (LWOSTRADA)**

Lwostrada is a great track if you want to sightsee around Olštyn by bike. You can start in Central Park **40** and go along Lyna towards the Old Town. After you pass the Castle, go under the spectacular brick overpass and you'll enter the forest part of the track. You can end your trip by the hydroelectric power station and go back or if you're ready for the off-town bike trip, continue with Lwostrada to Dobrze Miasto or even Lidzbark

**III. WALK TRACK**

Taking a circle around the entire Długie Lake is a must for the full Olštyn experience, so start your walk by the roundabout. When you've finished the circle, cross the rather busy Bałtycka street, and go along the small park **30** towards the biggest lake Uziel. There, go to the right all the time along the lake to avoid usually crowded promenades. Now you'll be walking the routes the locals usually do. Sit at the deck near olimpijska street and enjoy the unique smell.

**36. 5 MINUTES TO FULL RELAXATION**

This is one of those places that is real and metaphorical at the same time. Walking towards **The Bridges on Lyna** from Wojska Polskiego avenue, in a span of 200 metres, you move from one of the most densely populated parts of town filled with old tenement houses and XIX century barracks into... the middle of a forest. From reality to relaxation in 5 minutes. Every time.

5 minutes? For me - Kopernik? That's not enough! But okay, I'll try to make it short... I was born in Toruń, Poland, which you might have known, but I actually spent the most part of my life living in Warmia, and for a couple of years in Olštyn! After my studies, I became a canon at Warmian Chapter - simply because my uncle was a bishop here. But remember, I was not a priest at any point, even though I worked for the Church. I lived in Frombork, for most of my time, traveled around Warmia a lot and simply did my administration job. For 5 years I lived in Olštyn and took care of the chapter case here. Sounds

like a boring job to do, but maybe that's why I had so many hobbies: astronomy, economy, medicine and way more. I even led the defense of Olštyn castle against the Teutonic Knights attack in 1520 - in which I succeeded too. Here, in Olštyn, I wrote an important treatise on reform of money and also was doing measurements to finally achieve my biggest success - heliocentric theory. To this day, you can see my original handmade astronomical table on the wall of the Olštyn castle. Anyway, I spent about 40 years of my life in Warmia and finally died in Frombork in 1543. You can also pay me a visit there, at my grave - check out WHERE NEXT part of the map.

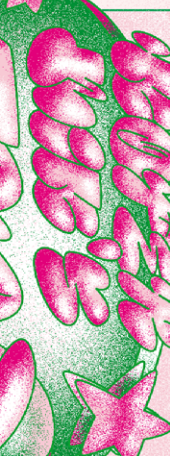
